



Complaints Authorization Committee

The Licensed Practical Nurses Act, 2005 outlines the following:

- Complaints Authorization Committee composition:
 - The Board will appoint at least 3 of its members, one of which must be a member appointed by the Minister of Health and Community Services to represent the public interest.
 - From these members, the Board shall appoint the chairperson and vice-chairperson of the committee.
 - The registrar is not eligible to be a member of the committee.

- The Board will appoint members to the CAC for a three-year term to a maximum of three (3) terms or a total of nine (9) consecutive years.

The primary function of the Complaints Authorization Committee (CAC) is to assist the CLPNNL in fulfilling its mandate of public protection by:

- Reviewing allegations received by the CLPNNL;
- Determining if a violation of the CLPNNL’s Standards of Practice or Code of Ethics has been committed by a Licensed Practical Nurse;
- Determining the best course of action based on the nature of the allegation.
