LPNS - A PRACTICAL APPROACH TO QUALITY CARE

The Excellence in Leadership Award in Nursing is specifically designed to acknowledge and show appreciation to a LPN who demonstrates excellence in leadership and commitment to the practical nursing profession. The award winner will receive a scholarship of \$500.00 towards continuing education and a framed certificate.

The process to nominate a LPN is as follows:

- Obtain the nominee's permission to submit his/her name for the nomination;
- Compile the necessary information on the nominee to support the statements identified in the criteria. Information may be obtained from a resume, personal information, an interview or from colleagues;
- Complete the nomination form and submit by May 10th, 2019;
- Obtain letters of endorsement from two people to support the nomination. If possible, one of these endorsements should be the nominee's supervisor.

To be considered for this award, the LPN must:

- Be a practicing LPN in NL who has maintained good standing throughout his/her career;
- Have a minimum of five (5) years practice experience as a LPN providing direct care.

The award will be given to a LPN who excels in the majority of the following criteria:

- Leads by example, demonstrating professionalism, respect and integrity and collegiality;
- Demonstrates commitment to personal and professional development;
- Advocates for nurses and nursing in the health-care setting;
- Demonstrates a positive attitude;
- Communicates effectively;
- Identifies and effectively promotes needed change;
- Provides mentorship to colleagues;
- Demonstrates passion for the work they perform.

Selection Process

The winner will be chosen by a selection committee that consists of 2 LPNs, a public representative and the chairperson of the College's Practice Committee. The information reviewed by the committee will exclude the name of the nominee.

Scholarship

- The candidate will have 2 years to complete one or more courses relevant to practical nursing. An extension may be granted if needed.
- Upon written confirmation that the candidate has registered for a course(s), a cheque will be issued to the educational facility.
- The scholarship covers tuition fees and any resources required to complete the course, such as textbooks.
