

Disciplinary Panel

The Licensed Practical Nurses Act, 2005 outlines the following:

- Disciplinary Panel composition:
 - \circ $\;$ The board will appoint at least 10 LPNs who are not members of the board.
 - The minister will appoint at least 3 persons, who are not LPNs, to represent the public interest.
- At the expiry of the term, a member continues to be a member until re-appointed or a replacement is appointed.
- When a complaint is referred to the disciplinary panel, the chairperson will appoint an adjudication tribunal consisting of 3 persons (2 LPNs & 1 member representing the public interest).
